M., Executive Director, Indian Bank**, handed over sewing machines to differently abled members of the **Society for Rights of All Women with Disabilities (SFRAWD)** at a programme held in Bank's Corporate Office in Chennai. The initiative aligns with Indian Bank's CSR focus area of "**Gender Equality and Women Empowerment**," aimed at fostering self-reliance and sustainable livelihood opportunities for women with disabilities.

SFRAWD, an all-women association for the disabled, has been working tirelessly to uplift its members through education, skill development, entrepreneurship and employment support. The society is affiliated with the Federation of Tamil Nadu Differently Abled Associations (FTNDAA) and the Women's Indian Association (WIA). It currently runs a dedicated training centre at Alwarpet, Chennai, imparting vocational skills to physically challenged women as well as mothers of differently abled children.
